### **Need More Training Hours For Licensing? Earning or Renewing Your CDA Credential? Entry Level Child Care Training For New Staff?**

All courses comply with the Oklahoma DHS Licensing requirements and are considered approved training hours, meet the formal education requirements of the CDA Competency Standards, and the STARS and REWARDS program requirements. Many courses meet the CDA Council's recommended criteria for earning continuing education units (CEU's). Call 828-2004 for more information.

#### **Entry Level Child Care Training (ELCCT) (FACS-3385)**

This DHS required 20-hour course provides new and/or future child care professionals with knowledge needed to provide quality care for young children while helping each individual child develop to his or her full potential. The course contains information and learning activities that stress the importance of the caregiver and of child care work. Students will receive a course textbook at no additional cost. (Bring a sack lunch/drink for Saturday classes.) Due to limited classroom space available this term, a maximum capacity of 20 students per ELCCT course will be strictly adhered to. Enroll early! (Tier II) 20 hours. Tuition: \$30

#### **Entry Level Child Care Training (ELCCT) Online (FACS-3460)**

This online version of the ELCCT course meets the DHS licensing requirements for entry level training for the first 90 days of employment in Oklahoma. Students will receive a course textbook at no additional cost. The course tuition of \$20 can be paid by cash, check, credit card or purchase order and is non-refundable and non-transferable. 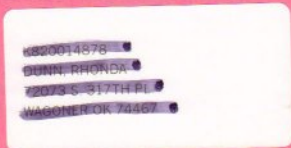
